## College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4

With these scores, students will be placed at a minimum in College Bridge 4 / Advanced English 4. After arriving in Seattle, students will take an English test and, depending on their results, may be placed in higher levels (CB5 / ADV5, CB6, or full-time college).

Students whose placement scores indicate Reading, Writing, or Listening proficiency two levels below College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4 will be placed in our Intensive English program and will not be placed in College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4.
