4. If you will transfer to another school and expect to be accepted within 60 days, please submit Transfer Out paperwork also, so that you can continue using the same SEVIS record.
5. An advisor will update your SEVIS record accordingly and send you an email message. Thank you!

IMPORTANT: *Your I-20 from Seattle Central College will become invalid. You will not be able to use it to re-enter the U.S. (this includes trips to Canada). If you are gone more than 5 months, you may need a new visa even if it has not expired.*
