#### Username & Password:

Your username and password are the same as your MySeattleColleges account (aka your @SeattleColleges.edu email address). Do not include the '@SeattleColleges.edu' portion in your Starfish username.

You can make an appointment with an Advisor by selecting the Advisor in your Success Network, and then selecting **Schedule**. (Watch a video)
