

January 23 is the last day to withdraw from a college class with a 50% tuition refund!

- College offices will use only the contact information in "My Central" to contact you regarding your enrollment and other updates at Seattle Central.


If we do **not** have your correct information, a **block** or "flag" will be put on your account, **blocking you from registration**.

#### ADDRESS TIPS:

- Some street names have directional markers—NE, SW, E, W,
- You can abbreviate parts of an address:

Street = St Avenue = Ave Boulevard = Blvd Drive = D

If you plan to move, update your address with the post office at <u>usps.com</u> so they can forward your mail. Also update it with your bank, utility companies, <u>Lewermark</u> insurance and anyone else who sends you mail.

Primary advisors are assigned to students when they first enroll at Seattle Central based on the spelling of their last name:



LewerMark is a Student Insurance company. The network of providers with Prist Health this insurance is called First Health. To get the best rates, you should see doctors/clinics who are in the First Health network!

> If someone at the doctor's office asks what insurance you have, tell them LewerMark and First Health.

International students are charged \$393.51 every guarter for insurance. It is added when a student registers for classes and may take 1-4 weeks to process.

Insurance is mandatory because healthcare in the U.S. is **EXTREMELY** expensive. This student insurance policy helps students cover costs.

NFW students will be able to access. their insurance card in the 3rd week of the quarter. Visit the IP Office if you have an urgent need.



## HOW TO SET UP AN APPOINTMENT WITH STARFISH?

To access Starfish and make an appointment, go to Seattle Central Current Students page.

- 1. Click the Starfish icon
- 2. Log in using your MySeattleColleges account credentials (Watch a video) (same login and password used for Wi-Fi and email)
- 3. Select your Advisor from Your Connections
- 4. Click Schedule from your Advisor's profile



## Username & Password:

Your username and password are the same as your MySeattleColleges account (aka your @SeattleColleges.edu email address). Do not include the '@SeattleColleges.edu' portion in your Starfish username.

## Requesting an Appointment:

You can make an appointment with an Advisor by selecting the Advisor in your Success Network, and then selecting **Schedule**.
