

Other English Proficiency

College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4



Students with the following proof of English proficiency can be admitted directly into College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4:

- **Canadian Academic English Language (CAEL):** 40 or higher
- **Duolingo English Test:** 30
- **Global Test of English Communication (GTEC):** 1040
- **International Test of English Proficiency (iTEP) Academic Plus:** 4.5 or higher
- **Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB):** 75 or higher
- **Pearson Test of English (PTE):** 41
- **TOEFL PBT*:** 470, writing 3
- **TOEFL Institutional**:** 470, no writing

*The TOEFL PBT is available in areas of the world where the iBT is not offered.

**The institutional TOEFL is accepted by special agreement only. To become an approved testing center, contact SeattleCentral.IntlMarketing@seattlecolleges.edu.

Other:

- **Completion of one year of study at a U.S. high school, or at a high school where English is the medium of instruction, taking no ESL classes.** Transcripts must show a B or 3.0 GPA, or placement in the top 20% of the class. If study occurred in countries where English is not the official language, proof that English was the medium of instruction may be required.
- **Completion of one year of study at an accredited post-secondary institution in Australia, Canada (English-speaking provinces), Ireland, Kenya, New Zealand, United Kingdom, United States, or Zimbabwe, without completion of English Composition.**

Upon arrival, students will take an English test and, depending on their results, may be placed in higher levels (CB5/ADV5, CB6, or full-time college).

Students whose placement scores indicate Reading, Writing, or Listening proficiency two levels below College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4 will be placed in our Intensive English program and will not be placed in College Bridge 4 or Advanced English 4.
