Other:

• Completion of one year of study at a U.S. high school, or at a high school where English is the medium of instruction, taking no ESL classes. Transcripts must show a B or 3.0 GPA, or placement in the top 20% of the class. If study occurred in countries where English is not the official language, proof that English was the medium of instruction may be required.

• Completion of one year of study at an accredited post-secondary institution in Australia, Canada (English-speaking provinces), Ireland, Kenya, New Zealand, United Kingdom, United States, or Zimbabwe, without completion of English Composition.

Upon arrival, students will take an English test and, depending on their results, may be placed in higher levels (CB5/ADV5, CB6, or full-time college).
