When you apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from City University of Seattle – even before you leave your home country!

---

## HERE'S HOW EASY IT IS!

- 1 Apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, indicating your transfer preference to City University of Seattle on your application.
- 2 Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Colleges, and a conditional letter of admission from City University of Seattle at the same time.
- 3 Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4 Complete the first two years of your bachelor's degree at Seattle Colleges by getting an associate degree.
- 5 Transfer to City University of Seattle to complete the last two years of your bachelor's degree.
- 6 Graduate and receive your bachelor's degree from **City University of Seattle!**

## TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY UNIVERSITY OF SEATTLE:

- 1 One quarter before completion of your associate degree with Seattle Colleges, call 206.239.4720 to schedule an appointment with your City University of Seattle academic advisor who will provide you with the list of required documentation for your final admission and transfer to City University of Seattle
- 2 Submit your final admissions documentation, including an official transcript from Seattle Colleges, no later than 1 month prior to the start of City University of Seattle's quarter
- 3 Upon admission, submit all required documents for F-1 student status and SEVIS transfer
