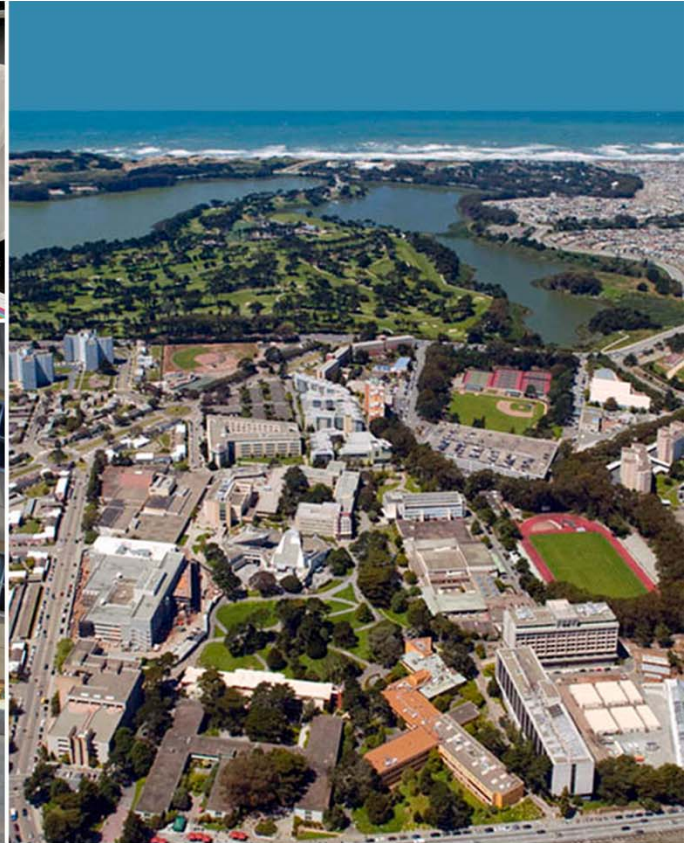

## San Francisco State University (SF State) Transfer Admission Agreement

Complete your lower-division coursework at Seattle Community College (SCC) and transfer to get a San Francisco State University bachelor's degree. Select SF State during the SCC application process and receive a Transfer Admission Agreement letter. Complete the SF State upper-division transfer requirements according to the SCC/SF State articulation agreement with an overall GPA of 2.0 or above, apply to SF State, complete the application process, and come to San Francisco State University.

## Admission Requirements for Undergraduate International Students

### Upper-Division Students (at least 60 semester/90 quarter transferable units):

- Complete the four admission subjects (oral communication, written communication, critical thinking, math) with minimum "C" grades or better by the end of the spring or fall term prior to transfer
- GE Critical thinking course is not required for Engineering majors
- Minimum Required GPA: 2.0 for most majors (please note that this has changed from the previous required minimum of 2.4)
- Impacted major programs may require a higher GPA
- English Language Proficiency is waived for upper-division transfer students that have completed the four admission subject requirements with "C" grades or better (TOEFL not required)

### Lower-Division Students (less than 60/90 transferable units):

- Must meet high school and college eligibility criteria
- High school & college transcripts are required
- Demonstrate English Language Proficiency by submitting TOEFL minimum score of iBT 61 or IELTS minimum score 6.0. This requirement is waived for students that have completed two semesters of university level written English composition with "C" grades or better

## Tuition/fees and Cost of Living for Undergraduate International Student

\$15,368 for an academic year with 12 minimum semester units required (\$372 per unit of credit) - Estimated total cost for one academic year of study and living expenses: **\$35,615**

## Undergraduate Application Filing Periods

### Fall semester (August – December):

Application filing period: October 1 – May 1  
Certain majors have earlier deadlines

### Spring Semester (January – May):

Application filing period: August 1 – September 30  
Certain majors do not accept Spring admission
