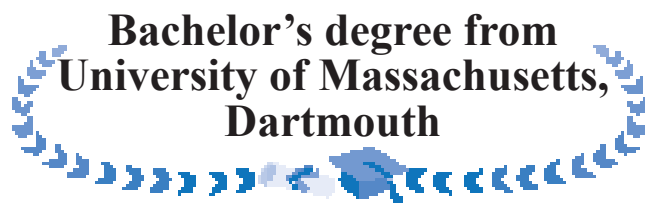


Transfer Admission Guarantee: University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth

When you apply for admission to Seattle Central College, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth – even before you leave your home country!

Here's how easy it is!

1. Apply for admission to Seattle Central College, indicating your transfer preference to University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth on your application.
2. Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Central College, and a conditional letter of admission from University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth at the same time.
3. Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
4. Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Central by getting an Associate's degree.
5. Transfer to University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
6. Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth!

Requirements for Transfer Admission Guarantee to University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth:

1. Complete an approved transferable associate's degree at Seattle Central College.
2. Earn a minimum 2.5 cumulative gpa on transferable credits from all previous institutions. Note that Biology, Chemistry, Engineering, and Medical Laboratory Science majors require a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.7. Students with a cumulative gpa of 3.25 or higher qualify to receive a merit scholarship; for more details, visit www.umassd.edu/financialaid/scholarships/admissions/.
3. Submit proof of English proficiency. English proficiency can be met through submitting test scores (pBT 520 / iBT 68 / IELTS 6) or by completing both English 101 and 102 with a grade of C or higher.
4. Submit an international application with official copies of all transcripts at www.umassd.edu/apply/.
5. Adhere to the University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth's deadlines for application and document submission, and admission policies.
6. Upon full admission, submit all required documents for F-1 student status and SEVIS transfer.
