
Transfer Admission Guarantee: Washington State University



When you apply for admission to Seattle Central College, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from Washington State University (WSU) – even before you leave your home country!

Here's how easy it is!

- 1. Apply for admission to Seattle Central College, indicating your transfer preference to Washington State University on your application.
- 2. Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Central College, and a conditional letter of admission from Washington State University at the same time.
- 3. Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Central College by getting an Associate's degree.
- 5. Transfer to Washington State University to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6. Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from Washington State University!

Specific Transfer Requirements for Washington State University:

- 1. Complete an Associate of Arts or Science degree at Seattle Central College with a 2.5 GPA.
- 2. Apply for International Undergraduate Admission to WSU-Pullman by the posted deadline at www.international.wsu.edu.
- 3. Send educational credentials and supporting information including transcripts or evaluation reports. View requirements online at www.ip.wsu.edu/apply/transcripts.html.
- 4. Complete and return the Certificate of Financial Responsibility and provide original, official and current proof of finances. See current costs online at www.ip.wsu.edu/apply/finances.html.
- 5. Meet WSU's English Language Proficiency (ELP) requirement by completing an Associate's degree with a 2.5 GPA. View other ELP waiver options at www.ip.wsu.edu/apply/admission-requirements.html.

NOTE: The above requirements satisfy general requirements for transfer admission to Washington State University. Some highly competitive majors at WSU have additional admission requirements. Please check with an advisor at Seattle Central or with WSU for a current list of these majors.
