When you apply for admission to Seattle Central College, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from Western Washington University – even before you leave your home country!

Here's how easy it is!

1. Apply for admission to Seattle Central College, indicating your transfer preference to Western Washington University on your application.
2. Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Central College, and a conditional letter of admission from Western Washington University at the same time.
3. Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
4. Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Central College by getting an Associate's degree.
5. Transfer to Western Washington University to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
6. Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from Western Washington University!

Transfer Requirements for Western Washington University:

1. Complete an approved transferable associate's degree at Seattle Central College (Associate of Arts, Associate of Science – Transfer or MRP transfer degrees).
2. Submit transcripts from all previous post-secondary institutions attended. If you earned credit in a country other than the U.S. or Canada, an official transcript evaluation from a NACES member institution may also be requested by the Admissions Committee (www.naces.org/members.htm).
3. Earn a minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average on transferable credit from all previous institutions attended.
4. Meet WWU's English Proficiency requirements by completing English Composition I (ENGL& 101) and English Composition II (ENGL& 102) with a 3.0 GPA. Or submit an official TOEFL iBT score of 80 or IELTS score of 6.5 or above.
5. Submit an International Undergraduate Application for Admission by the application deadline for the term of application (admissions.wvu.edu/apply).
6. Submit a signed Statement of Financial Responsibility and official bank statement.

Please note that while many academic majors are open to all interested students, others are competitive, requiring a separate admissions application, prerequisite coursework and/or an elevated grade point average. Please note that admission to Western Washington University does not guarantee admission to a specific academic program.
